These implants serve as secure anchors for a fixed, non-removable full-arch prosthesis, providing patients with a stable, functional, and natural-looking smile.

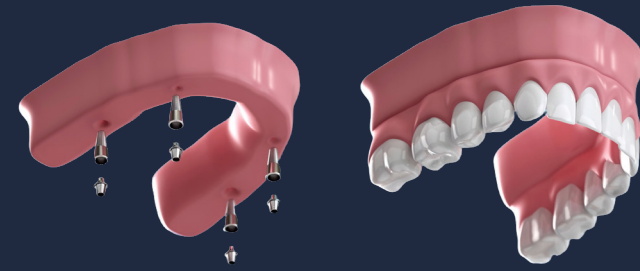
Unlike traditional dentures, All-on-4 teeth are permanently attached and do not rely on adhesives or suction. The implants are positioned to maximize available bone—often with the posterior implants placed at an angle—allowing for strong support while frequently avoiding the need for bone grafting.

This streamlined approach allows many patients to restore their smile with fewer implants, fewer procedures, and a shorter overall treatment timeline.
